MGs and Friends of the BBG, we are looking for seeds and cuttings of your favorite plants.

One emphasis for this sale will be a focus on growing pollinator plants – hosts and nectar.

All of our plants are grown in sterile containers using sterile growing medium. We do not use neonic pesticides and practice Integrated Pest Management controls. All of our plants have been grown and nurtured by certified UF/IFAS Extension Brevard Master Gardeners.

Based on what sold, and did not sell, the following plant types are **NOT needed:**

Common aloe, Century agave, sansevieria, Devil's backbone (*Pedilanthus tithymaloides*, *Tithymalus tithymaloides*), Gardenia (unless grafted), Cast Iron plant (unless variegated), Buddleia x weyeriana "Honeycomb" Yellow --we welcome all other Buddleias.
